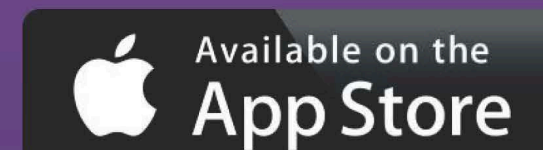

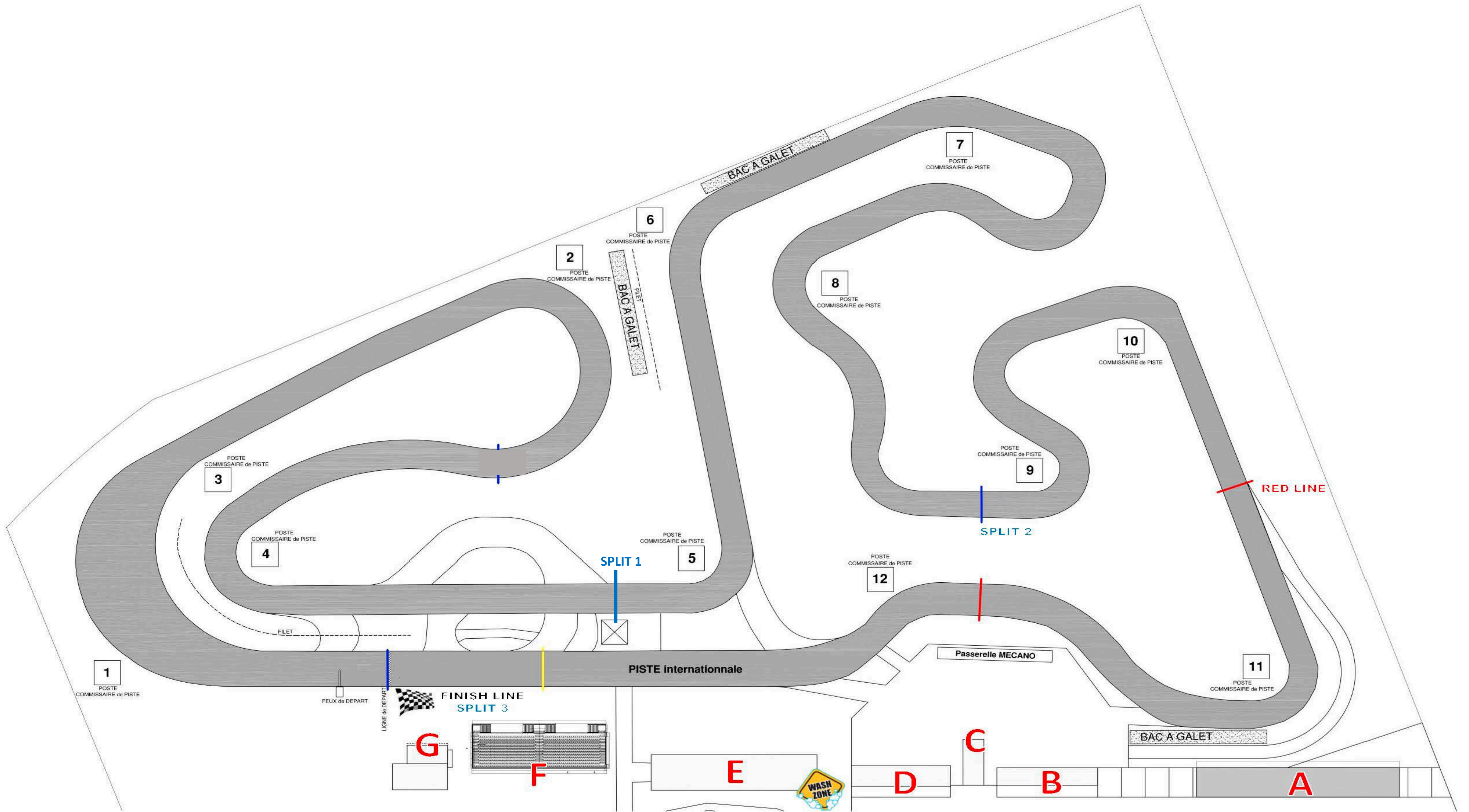

STARTING GRID:

Lotery: every driver must draw a lottery ball after the Non Qualifying session. The number on the ball will allocate the place on the grid.

X30 Master-Senior Cup: 6 minutes

DURATION OF SESSION:

14' MINUTES + 1 Lap (11' MINUTES + 1 Lap for IAME MINI & IAME MINI ROOKIE)

NOTE: 1 Warm-Up Lap + 1 Formation Lap

EVENT PODIUM

Top 3 drivers of the official result of the Final will be invited to the podium

CHAMPIONSHIP PODIUM

Top 3 drivers of the official Championship result will be invited to the podium

IWF TICKETS

Drivers eligible for IWF tickets will be invited to the podium

NOTE: Race suit + Helmet is mandatory for the podium ceremony

START PROCEDURE

01

Not able to follow in Warm-Up Lap

In case a driver slows down in the Warm-Up lap, for whatever reason, he is not allowed to wait until the grid will pass him (again) to take his original starting position back in the grid. At all times he must take his places back at the end of the grid. If it is a 'wrong' start the driver still must stay at the end of the grid...

02

Formation Lap

When approaching MP 10 the polesitter slows down to a reasonable speed limit, meaning that the grid will be compact and in two lines. Overtaking after the RED LINE is not allowed. Again, with reasonable speed the grid will line up to the startline. When the light switch from RED to OUT the start has been given. If a yellow light will flashes there will be a extra formation lap. In case there are two wrong starts the RED flag will showed. All karts must stop before the Yellow line. After post 10 it is not allowed any more to heating up the tires ("zig-zagging"). Offenders will be penalized with an Official Warning.

Karts standing on the pre-grid because of help or where not in time on the pre-grid must stay in the repair area.

03

Red flag within the first 2 laps of the race

There will be a completely new start.

Karts standing on the pre-grid because of help or where not in time on the pre-grid must take there originally grid position.

START PROCEDURE

04**During Formation lap**

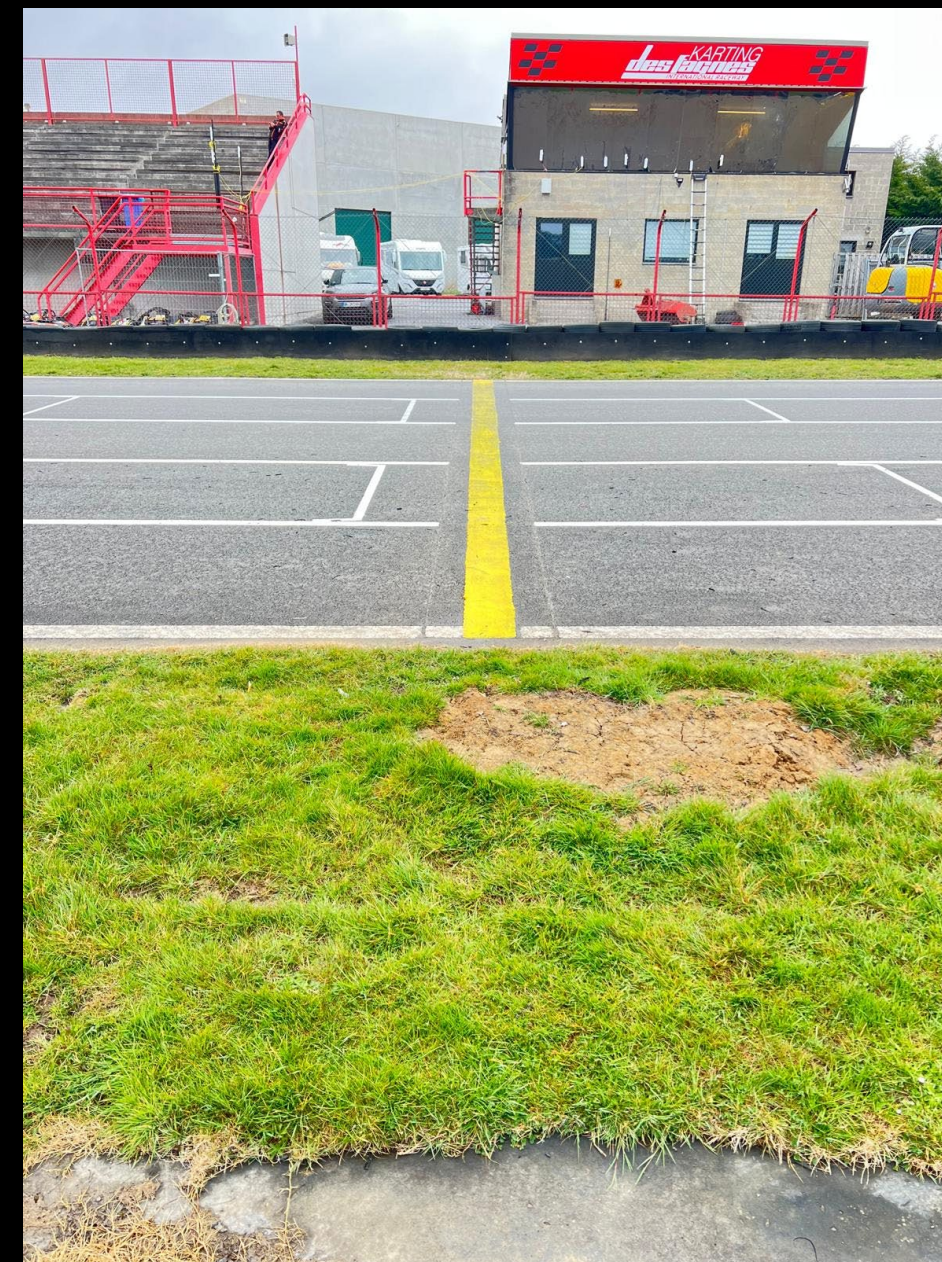
No overtaking after the RED line. The RED line is marked between Post 10 & Post 11

05**During Formation lap**

Between Red line and Yellow line reasonable speed. After Post 10 it is not allowed to do 'zig-zagging'. Offenders will be directly penalized (official warning).

25 mtrs in front of Startline

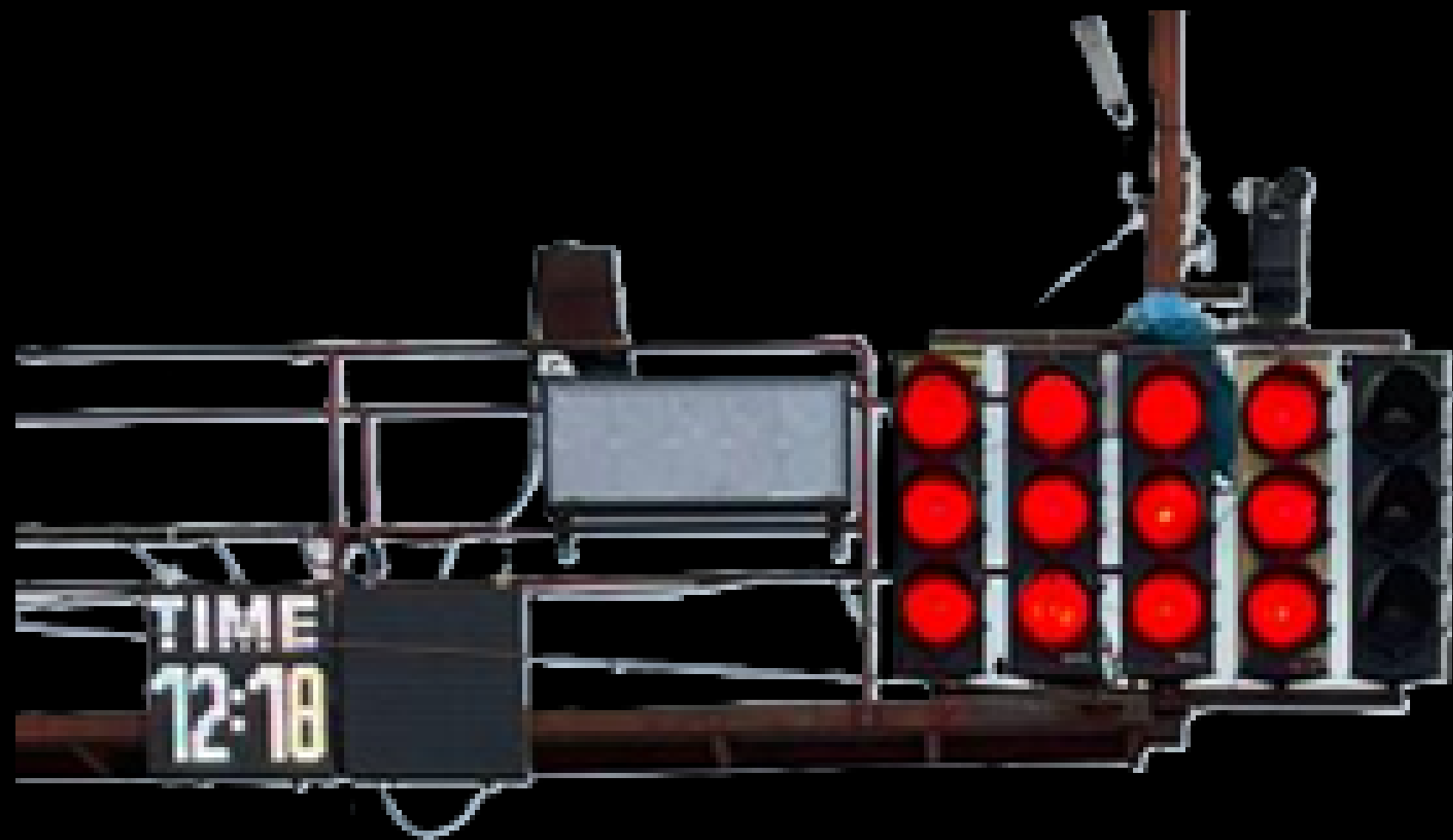
START PROCEDURE

06**During Formation lap**

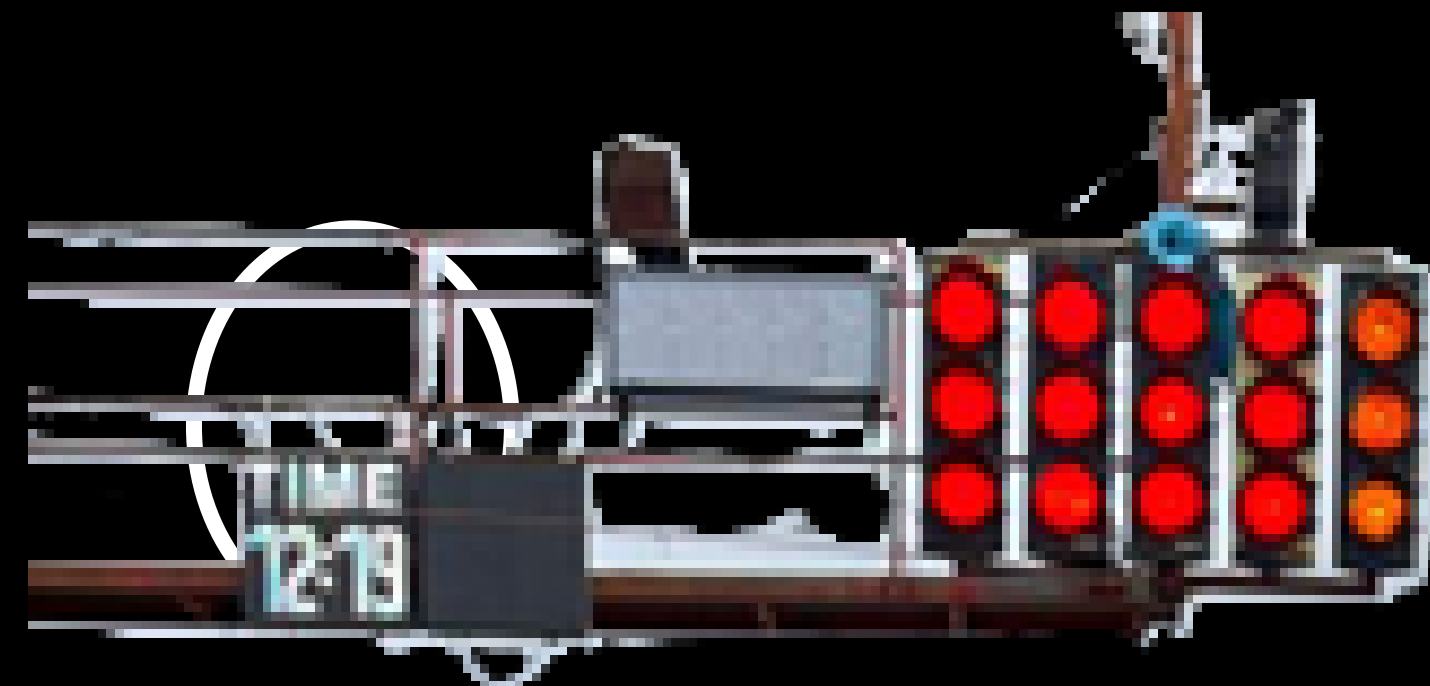
RED lights are switched ON. Stay in the corridor.

07**During Formation lap**

RED lights & Orange flashing light are ON. One extra formation lap.

START PROCEDURE

08**During Formation lap***After two 'false starts' RED Flag will be showed on Start line***09****During Formation lap***RED lights OFF: WE ARE RACING*

SLOW PROCEDURE

01**Start of Slow procedure**

In case of a 'SLOW' procedure the YELLOW flashing light will be switched on at the Starting Line

02**Marshall Posts**

Marshall posts will show the 'SLOW' board panel and a waved yellow flag. The leader of the race will slow down to a reasonable speed (compare with safety car situation in F1). Overtaking is strictly forbidden

03**Duration of Slow procedure**

There is no time limit to end the slow procedure. The slow procedure will end if soon as the track is back safe to race again

04**End of Slow procedure**

The YELLOW flashing light will be switched off at the Starting Line. The Marshall post will still show the 'SLOW' board panel, but now with a STATIONARY yellow flag, meaning that the next passing on the Starting line the GREEN flag could be showed.

If the GREEN flag will be showed on the Starting line, we are racing again and overtaken is allowed after the green flag!!!

AT ALL TIMES THE RED FLAG CAN BE SHOWED

SHORT CUTS

01**Warm Up Lap – Formation Lap – Out Lap**

It is not allowed to do a short cut, for what ever reason, during these laps. If a driver makes a short cut it will be reported to the Stewards.

02**Qualifying – Heat – Final**

*Every short cut, for whatever reason, with or without gaining position or time, will be penalized.
Sanction: placed last in session.*

IMPEDING / BLOCKING

01**Qualifying**

Impeding and/or blocking in Qualifying will be penalized with a drop down of 5 places.

02**Heat – Final**

Impeding and/or blocking in these sessions will be penalized. First time it will be a Warning Flag. Second time a 5 seconds Time Penalty will be given. A report to the Stewards if it is more than 2 times. They will review the video footages and will take a decision.

SPECIFIC CONCERNS RELATED TO THE TRACK

01

Entrance Repair area

The entrance of the repair area is after Post 11, and will be open during Warm-Up, Non Qualifying, Qualifying Heats and Finals. The entrance is closed during Qualifying sessions.

02

Entrance Parc Ferme (Scale)

*The entrance of the the Parc Ferme area (scale) is at the straight after Post 10. This entrance will be always open during EACH session, **BUT** you use this entrance **ONLY** during Qualifying Session and after the checkered flag after each session.*

03

Drones

Using drones by third parties on the site of Karting Des Fagnes is strictly forbidden. Offenders will be noted. In worse case the Race Director is allowed to end the competition.

PARC FERMÉ TIRES

01**Voucher**

Tires vouchers must be turned over in Parc Fermé. It is mandatory to fit the tires on the rims in the Servicing Parc. Fitting tires on rims must be done DIRECTLY. It is not possible to do this at a later stage during the event.

02**Race tires**

All race tires, slicks & wets stays in Parc Fermé the entire event. The tires will be scanned and marked with the racenumber.

03**Collecting tires**

When entering for Qualifying, Heat or Final, the driver shows his badge to collect his set of tires. The option to take also the wet tires is only so if the Race Director declared the session to a WET RACE.

04**Returning tires**

After Qualifying and Heat the driver returns the tires to the tires allocated place. Drivers who are not placed for the Finals can collect their tires after the respective FINAL.

05**Non Qualifying – Warm Up**

It is not allowed to use Parc Fermé tires during Non Qualifying and, or Warm Up sessions.

GENERAL (PADDOCK) INFORMATION

01**Allocated place**

The driver and team are responsible for their allocated place.

02**Spilling lubricants**

It is not allowed to spill any lubricants on the surface. Offenders can be penalized by the trackowner

03**Heating up engines**

It is not allowed to heating up engines.

Just firing up the engine (to check if it starts) is allowed.

04**Used tires**

Place your used tires in front of your tent. Members from the track will collect them a few times a day.

05**Fire extinguishers**

Fire extinguishers should be placed on a visible spot in the tent. Minimum one per driver and per 4 drivers two.

06**Electric vehicles**

Electric vehicles, like steps, bikes, etc. are not allowed in the Paddock, Servicing Parc, Parc Fermé and Restaurant area

GENERAL (PADDOCK) INFORMATION

07**Cars**

Personal cars are not allowed in the Paddock.

08**Overnight**

*It is **STRICTLY** forbidden to overnight in the Paddock. Offenders will be noted by the track owner.*

09**Opening hours**

Respect the opening hours from the Paddock and Restaurant

10**After the event**

*Since we are all guests at **de Karting Des Fagnes** we must behave us as guest. Take care that after the event you leave your allocated place in a proper and clean way.*


