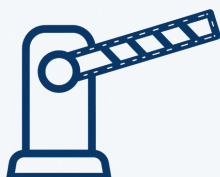


CAMPING ACCES

Access to the campsite is regulated and only allowed with a staff-issued voucher to maintain safety and organization.

CLOSING PADDOCK

Entry after closing hours is considered trespassing. Please check the schedule for opening and closing times.



ENTRY & CLOSING

All access to and from the paddock and camping area must go through the designated barrier.

NO PERSONAL CARS

Personal vehicles or electrical steps are not allowed on the paddock to ensure safety, accessibility, and a clean environment for all participants. Use a bicycle!



KARTWASHING

it is **FORBIDDEN** to clean karts in the paddock, please use the kart cleaning area near the entrance to the Parc Fermé. **No trucks or van washing on this site.** Please refer to the following car & truck wash on the Kruisbosstraat 2 in Bilzen with this pricelist

Do not place your awning anywhere on the paddock, speak to staff to get an allocated paddock space.

The price of the camping space depends on the duration and size of the space.

In attendance of the participants of the EK, the occupied camping is provided on the motorcross site. You can find this zone marked as number 1 on the map.

Sunday 26.07.2026 at 19:00 the campsite must be completely empty. If you plan on staying longer, inform a Karting Genk staff.



Obligation of RFID-stickers

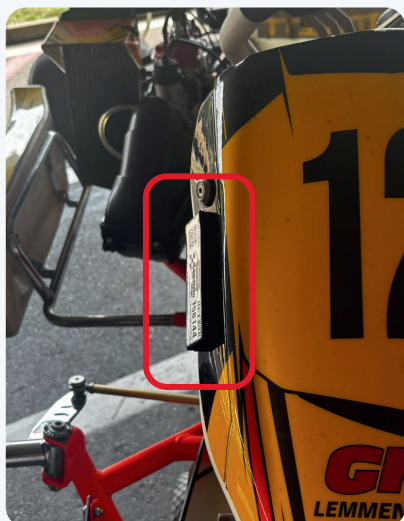
Since the beginning of this year, Karting Genk has been conducting permanent noise measurements. To ensure that these work properly, every kart must be equipped with an **RFID-sticker**.

This means that from now on, it will be mandatory to drive with your start number.

Upon entering the pre-grid, Karting Genk staff will affix an RFID-sticker to your kart, which will then be scanned into the system via a computer. The sticker will be affixed to the left side of the nasseau panel.

IMPORTANT:

Allow sufficient time to be present at the pre-grid for the first sessions. Without a start number, no RFID-sticker can be affixed. Without an RFID-sticker, you cannot participate in the practice sessions!



If your sticker contains metal or aluminium, you must first apply a foam. The RFID sticker should then be attached to the seat foam.

ALL WASTE MUST BE TAKEN HOME

Unless your waste is sorted in transparent bags provided by Karting Genk staff.

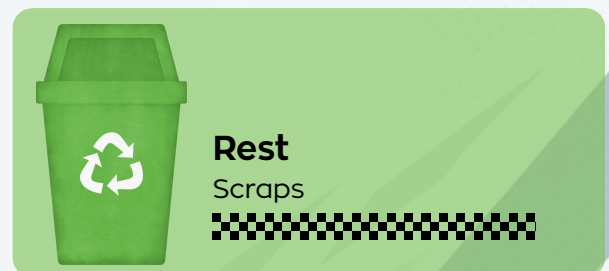

Tyres can be disposed in the appropriate container.

PENALTIES & FINES

At our circuit, respect for the environment is not optional. It is a shared responsibility.

All teams are expected to maintain a clean and safe paddock area at all times and to strictly follow all environmental regulations in place. Any team found leaving waste behind, disposing of waste in another team's area, or failing to manage their rubbish responsibly will receive a €500 fine.

The same penalty applies to any fuel or oil spillage caused by negligence or improper handling.

Only bicycles are allowed on the premises; e-scooters are strictly prohibited.

As a circuit and as part of the motorsport community, we must work together to reduce our environmental impact and protect the surroundings in which we race. Respecting these rules helps preserve the environment and ensures a safe and professional atmosphere for everyone involved.

We cannot achieve this alone.

Your cooperation, teamwork, and respect for the regulations are essential. Only together can we maintain a clean, responsible, and sustainable event environment.
